

Does your student have a hearing loss???

Steps to follow:

Step 1: Hearing screening with **Speech Therapist** at the school.

After two failed hearing screenings, then -

Step 2: Full audiometric testing at the sound-booth with

District Audiologist, Randy Bartholomew

To schedule an appointment: Parents call Cindy Fackler at 634-0092, ext. 300. Parents take student to appointment.

If student is found to have a hearing loss, then -

Step 3: Audiogram sent to school: given to **Special Education Teacher and/or Speech Therapist**

Copy of audiogram also sent to:

Rachel Parry, Teacher for the Deaf/Hearing Impaired

(Audiogram can be sent through the district mail to Rachel's office at the District Office.)

School team contacts Rachel for assistance (after all hearing testing has been completed) regarding:

- *assessment for Special Education or 504 Plan eligibility determination process. Rachel can collaborate with the Speech Therapist in giving communication skills assessments.
- Rachel is part of the IEP/504 team and will attend the meetings.
- Rachel's services for communication skills development and/or in-service to teachers and staff, etc. may be listed on the IEP/504 plan.

*Student may not have any communication or academic delays. SPED or 504 services may not be needed.
